 - Age 13-19 as of January 1, Current Year.
 - Submitted & Paid Declaration Fee to attend KCYF
- Must be KEEP level Novice Intermediate or above; Pattern must be dated **06/26/2020** or prior.
 - Previous year's level of Novice Intermediate or above rating can be used.

2) Application Requirements

- Member and Project Equine Information
- Letter of Recommendation- Must have a hand-written signature
- KEEP Dismounted Skills & Pattern - Novice Int&Adv/Junior/Senior/Horsemaster Level by **06/26/2020**.
- Show points – member/project animal.
 - A minimum of 1 show and a maximum of 4 shows must be attended.
 - Shows must be attended between **08/01/2019** and **06/26/2020**.
 - Ties will be by points earned at the River Run Shows.
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- All pages must be included.
- Applications due by Noon, **06/26/20**. Applications must be turned into the Extension office.
- Electronic submissions will not be accepted.

Show Point Requirements

- ❖ 4 shows (pleasure, speed (barrel), jumping, dressage, equestrian meets) between 8/01/2020 thru 06/26/2020
- ❖ Points are based on a member/project equine.
- ❖ **Show bill must be included for each show where points are earned**
- ❖ **Show bill MUST BE SIGNED by Show Manager/Show Secretary to be counted.**
- ❖ Placing and number in class must be included on the record sheets below for the points to count.
- ❖ Maximum of 4 classes per show count toward points; maximum of 96 points (4 shows) possible.
- ❖ Only list classes from approved classes listed below.
- ❖ May include multiples of one type of class, i.e. 2 showmanship, 2 saddle seat equitation, etc.
- ❖ *Grand & Reserve and Sweepstakes classes do not count.*
- ❖ Points will be based on 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1 placings.

 - ◆ Hunt Seat Discipline
 - ◆ Discipline Rail/Command Class
 - ◆ Dressage Seat Equitation/Suitable to be a Dressage Horse
 - ◆ Maximum of 4 dressage tests (include copy of complete score sheet)
 - ◆ Showmanship (Hunt Seat, Saddle Seat and/or Western style)
 - ◆ Stock Seat Equitation/Western Horsemanship/Western Pleasure
 - ◆ Hunt Seat/Saddle Seat (English) Equitation/Hunt Seat/Saddle Seat (English) Pleasure
 - ◆ Saddle Seat Pattern (Medal Classes included)
 - ◆ Trail and English/Western Riding/Reining
