- Every kid goes through all 8 classes
  - Showmanship – Mike Elliot, Reining – Bob Walton, Patterns – Marc DeLisle, Trail – Leesa Massman, Grooming – Tammy Watkins, Training – Charlie Closser, Speed – Melinda Pepper, Dressage - ?
- Lunch provided both days
- Encouraging parents to take horses/kids home – if you choose to stay it's \$20 per night for overnight – you are responsible for all your cleanup
- Observation w/o horse is free – but need to supply own lunch

### New Business:

- New Ground Pole patterns are on the horse leader website
- KFNO Judges gift cards
  - The KFNO committee has made a recommendation to increase the gift cards from \$25 to \$50 for each judge.
  - Fuel has risen over the last several years and we need to cover their fuel for coming
  - Horse Leaders to kick in the additional \$285 (\$31/show)
  - Sabrina motioned to have the horse leaders pay the additional \$285 MSC
- Sprinkler System – a company has offered to provide sprinkler system for the arena that they will maintain in lieu of a banner in lieu of a sprinkler system
  - Motion to look into this offer made by Lori Dunham MSC
- Quotes have come in
  - Electrical Update in Barns – outlets through ceilings of all barns (the service was already upgraded to accommodate) to run fans
    - \$9648 for all four barns (contractor donating \$1589 off original price of \$11,237)
  - Wash Rack Repairs – remove all wood and replace with metal piping with airline cables to prevent going under
    - \$3000 with coated cable or \$3600 with all steel
    - Idea of using telephone poles and landscape timbers – 4 poles across and three sections of timbers bolted on
    - If we replace with what is there – it will last 5-8 years – looking at around \$6-/\$700
    - Holly made a motion to get a quote to replace existing wash rack lumber with properly treated wood and complete it if the quote comes in under \$2000 MSC 15 yea 4 nay
  - Dave meeting to get quote on drainage options on 4/5
    - Sabrina made motion to move forward with drainage if the quote comes in at or under \$6000 MSC 19 yea 0 nay
      - What is budget in our account?
        - Need to keep \$20,000 in acct to run a year
        - There are some earmarked monies for camp and future budgets for committees like jumping cups

- Explorer Declaration Form with \$15 Declaration Fee (*no refunds*)
- Assumption of Risk Waiver – One per family w/ each member listed & signed
- Helmet Education Form – One per family with each member listed and signed

#### June 6 – Horse Leader Meeting

- Declaration Form for members who filed an Intent to Declare in May
- Double Stall Form with \$50 fee

#### June 15

- Camping, Premium Statements... due to the FAIR office in LOWELL

#### June 28

- State 4-H Horse Show (Aug 9-11) application packet to MSUE on Ball Ave by NOON

#### June 30

- 2013 Early Release *Request* to Dave Pachulski (with required documentation) Fair guidelines prevent early releases prior to Friday @7pm with the exception of the State Horse Show.

#### July 11 - Horse Leader Meeting

- 2<sup>nd</sup> half of the Declaration Fee (\$50) per member due – can be turned in any time before this date (*no refunds*)

#### July 12 – The following items are due to the Extension Office before 3:00pm (can be turned in early)

- Immunization and Negative Coggins Form with each member/explorer copies filed alphabetically
  - Required: Tetanus, Eastern/Western Encephalomyelitis, Rabies and West Nile - Negative Coggins dated September 2012 or later

- KEEP Book – Dismounted Abilities for appropriate division – Evaluation Patterns
- KEEP Pattern for level change within division
- Stable Record Book including copies of Immunizations and Negative Coggins
- Age appropriate Explorer Record Book with dismounted abilities for 7-8 year olds
- Horseless Record Book; Horseless Dismounted Abilities; Horseless Project Elements
- Gymkhana, Jumping and Jumping Prep Evaluations
