- Sand in New arena was leveled out by Matt. Lake Raimer is no more and very few puddles were left after last big rain. HURRAY!!!! West warm up arena is still deep and soft.
- Fan will be had by all. YAY... Remember to use proper equipment when setting up fans. (Adaptor, 14 gage extension cord, Power strip) Do not plug fans into Christmas tree lights! Fans must be mounted above stalls, not in front of stall. If fire marshal says no to fans they will have to come down.
- Each barn and announcer stand has fire extinguisher now.
- WZZM will be at fair on Monday covering the horse area. Our two horsemasters will be meeting with them.
- We are using the same exit strategy as last year. Directions are in Leader Packets. Contact Matt with questions. Decorations can be taken down at 4:00 and horses can leave at 5:00.
- Making Strides will be first club to leave on Saturday the 12th so that Phelps barn walls can be taken down to allow pens from beef and hogs to be moved in on Sunday the 13th.
- Horses are allowed to come to fair any time on Sunday the 6th until 6:00 pm or Monday the 7th until 8:00am.
- No vehicles are allowed to park east of the barns. Drop off your horses and move it on out.
- Please, Please, Please communicate parking directions to whoever is dropping off horses or just driving to fairgrounds.
- Explorers: Make sure coggins and vet records are turned in if explorer is hauling in a horse on Monday. We are asking that hauled in horses arrive between 9:00 and 12:00. They must be tied to trailer and cannot come into horse barn area.
